Maroon State School Homework Guidelines:

Students will bring home a book each night to read. Every student will have a reading log which parents are asked to sign daily. Students read his or her books for a minimum of 10-15min every day. Teachers will check this log each morning and support the home reading selection process. Students who need to develop their sight word bank will bring home sight words to be read and reviewed as often as possible at home to develop quick recall and provide a strong reading foundation.
